



**Research Foundation for Mental Hygiene, Inc.
Salary Deduction Agreement
Voluntary Contributions to the Emeriti Health Account**

By this Agreement, made between _____ (employee) and the Research Foundation for Mental Hygiene, Inc. the parties hereto agree as follows:

Effective with respect to amounts earned on or after _____ (date), a deduction from the employee's salary will occur each bi-weekly pay period in the amount indicated below. The deductions will be remitted to the employee's Emeriti Health Account.

This Agreement shall be legally binding on both parties (named above) while employment continues, or until such time as the employee provides written notice of a change in his/her contribution amount or termination of his/her contributions to the Emeriti Health Account. An employee may make changes to his/her salary deduction agreement at any time, in accordance with the advanced notice procedures and other processes established by the Foundation.

The employee elects one of the following options for voluntary contributions to the Emeriti Health Account by means of salary deduction:

This plan allows voluntary employee contributions starting at age 21.
